In addition to your child's classroom teacher, they learn from many other amazing teachers in our building on a regular basis. Be sure to ask your child about them!

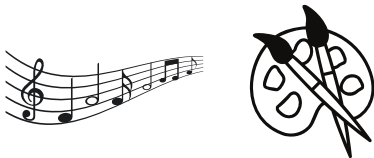
Library / Lit Lab: Each week your child will visit the library and have the opportunity to check out books for their classroom or to take home.

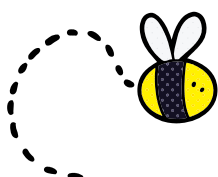


Music/Art: Mrs. Casper teaches music and art to our elementary students. Students enjoy music instruction 4 days/week and art instruction 1 day/week.
