He farmed with his father until it was obvious that the farm wouldn't support both of them. Jerry moved to Tecumseh in 1961 but always cherished the farm that had been his home. After his untimely death from renal cancer in 2009, his family wanted to return the generous memorial gifts from former high school classmates, family, and friends from the Superior area to students from Superior High School who are interested in continuing their education in agricultural courses.

### SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

The scholarship will be in the amount of \$250.00 and will be awarded at the annual FFA Banquet. The scholarship will be paid to the school of choice after the completion of the first semester, to be used to cover second semester expenses.
