Formative and summative assessments, along with proficiency scales, are being developed and utilized so we know exactly what our students have learned or still need to learn. Grade level teams are meeting regularly to review academic and behavior data to guide our instruction. As with any new learning, this process can be challenging at times but I am so proud of our staff's dedication to this challenge!
