Thursday, Dec. 9 at 7:00pm

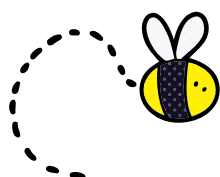
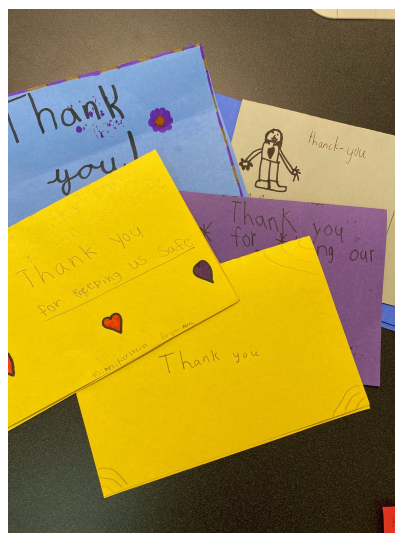
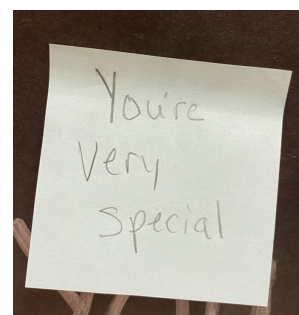
