

SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA

Application Guidelines

Candidates must:

- 1. be a graduate of an accredited high school within the membership boundaries of NAIFA-Nebraska;
- 2. be interested in furthering their education, with preference given to candidates interested in courses of study such as education, business/management/finance, marketing/sales, or actuarial studies; and preference given to those who attend a Nebraska university, college, or community college.
- 3. have an above-average grade point average in high school;
- 4. demonstrate good character, leadership, and interest in furthering their education.

Candidates must **not**:

1. be the child of a National Association of Insurance and Financial Advisors (NAIFA) association.

Selection Guidelines:

- 1. Candidates shall **not** have to show financial need.
- 2. Selection shall not be based on consideration of age, sex, race, creed, or disability.
- 3. Selection shall be made by members of NAIFA-Nebraska.
- 4. Scholarship funds will be disbursed directly to the college or university to be applied to the recipient's tuition. In the event that circumstances dictate disbursement of scholarship funds directly to the recipient, recipient must show proof of matriculation at the college or university.
