Dear Parents/Guardians,

Welcome back to the new school year. Grades 1-12 will all have a chromebook assigned to them at the start of the year. Each student will be receiving a chromebook policy with their student handbook that needs to be signed and returned. All students in grades 1-8 will not take the chromebook off campus at the end of the day. Each of those students will have a dedicated charging cart to place them in safely for the night. There will be situations where students in grades 1-8 may take a device home to continue work. All situations will be cleared with administration approval prior. All students 9-12 have the option to take devices home. Students are not required to take devices home, but are encouraged to continue working on educational activities. All grades will be monitored 24/7 through GoGuardian on and off campus. GoGuardian will trigger alerts to the district administrator if there is any suspicious or harmful activity. All alerts will be emailed to parents as a PDF.

All technology devices are owned and maintained by the school district. Having a device is a privilege and can be taken away at any time. All damages need to be reported as soon as possible to the Technology Director. Any tampering or unauthorized apps will not be permitted and will result in the loss of device privileges.
