- 1. Updating required state school immunizations according to the 2023-24
- 2. Performing hearing, dental and vision screenings, along with height/weight/and BMI assessments once throughout the school year. Will be working with the Lions Club again this year on 01/10/2024.
- 3. Developing asthma, seizure, and diabetes action plans, and assisting with the concussion screenings. - 4. Assisting with student observations for IEP's.
- 5. Assisting with the monitoring of the administration of medications and treatments at the school. **STATE LAW REQUIRES** that *all* school medications come in the **original** bottles from the pharmacy. Any medication dosage changes an original doctor's note is to be brought to the school, for all medications given at school, or with **ALL** school activities. Further, the <u>original</u> doctors order must accompany any medication dosage changes given at the school.
- 6. Assisting ALL staff with any student food allergies; example- peanuts, eggs etc...
- 7. Monitoring staff medication administration, and conduction of CPR training, updating/maintaining all AED's, Epi-Pens, nebulizer's, and other emergency equipment.
- 8. Educational opportunities; COVID19, Growth & Development, Nutrition, Hygiene, Concussion awareness.
- 9. This will be the 6<sup>th</sup> year teaching the Certified Nursing Assistance course through Hastings Community College.
